

<p style="text-align: center;">Geography</p> <p>In Geography we will be using maps and atlases to locate volcanoes around the world. On our own maps we will create a key. We will then be looking at what affect volcanoes, earthquakes and tsunamis can have on an area. We will talk about these natural disasters using technical and geological language. We also compare geological features in different areas.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>We will start our topic by looking at different rocks. We will learn about how rocks are formed and will test the different properties of them. One focus of this investigation will be writing a method and then a conclusion sharing what we have found out.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">MFL – French</p> <p>This term we will continue learning some French. We will learn how to say hello and goodbye as well as introduce ourselves and talk about where we live and how old we are. We will be learning about how to say members of our family.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>Our main topic this term will be fractions. We will start by looking at what a fraction is and how to find fractions of shapes. We will learn about how to make a whole and where fractions go on a number line. Next we will look at how to find fractions of amounts, equivalent fractions and adding and subtracting fractions. We will be writing character and setting descriptions before moving onto looking at how to plan and write a well-structured story. In SAPG we will be focusing on the use of apostrophes, inverted commas and paragraphs. In Guided Reading we will be reading ‘The Firework Makers Daughter’ which links to our topic.</p>
