

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Geography</b></p> <p>We will spend part of the topic looking at how Britain has changed over time, looking at some different geographical features.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Science</b></p> <p>As part of our topic this term we will be looking at how shadows are formed and how they can change throughout the day. We will also look at the cycle of a flowering plant.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>MFL – French</b></p> <p>This term we will learn how to say different colours and countries as well as counting up to 20.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths</b></p> <p>This term we will be looking at telling the time. We will start by looking at day, months and years and how to use a calendar. Then we will look at telling the time to the nearest minute on analogue clocks, before telling the time on a digital clock. Alongside this we will be converting between 12 and 24 hour clocks. Finally we will look at the time durations of different events and how to calculate them. Each week we will also have a session looking at the four different operations and how to answer arithmetic questions.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>English</b></p> <p>Our text in English will be ‘Stone Age Boy’ which links to our topic. We will use this to help us write character and setting descriptions. We will then look at adventure stories, what makes them exciting and how we can write our own adventure stories? In SPAG we will concentrate on past and present tense, inverted commas and apostrophes. In Guided Reading our text will be ‘The Worst Witch’.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PE</b></p> <p>Outdoor PE – Indoor PE – Swimming /circuits</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Year 3 Curriculum Overview Summer Term 1 Tribal Tales</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>History</b></p> <p>This term we will be looking at 3 main time periods: Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age. We will look at how things in Britain changed throughout the time periods. We will also use a variety of sources to investigate how people lived during the different time periods such as their houses and food etc.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>Being Safe This term we will start by looking at what foods make up a healthy diet and why it is important to eat healthily. Then we will look at friendships and what to do if a friendship goes wrong. We will then look at what we can do if we get stressed and how to help keep ourselves calm before learning about different cultures and customs.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Art</b></p> <p>We will use a variety of paint techniques to create our own cave paintings, like the ones created in the Stone Age. Towards the end of the topic we will use a variety of materials to make some different types of jewellery linked to ones made in the time period.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>RE</b></p> <p>Hindu Beliefs – we will focus on the key question: ‘How can Brahman be everywhere and in everything?’ We will look at who Hindus think Brahman is and that he is one god but in different forms. We will do this through reading different stories about Hindu beliefs.</p>
