

<p style="text-align: center;">Personal, Social and Emotional</p> <p>Now the children are all happily settled in Nursery, we will be supporting the children to strengthen their friendships through our 'Golden Values.' Over the rest of this term through small adult led activities and the children's interests we will be learning about several traditions such as 'Bonfire Night,' and Christmas.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Communication and Language</p> <p>We will follow the children's interests through their play and plan small adult led activities to develop and extend the children's communication and language skills. From visiting Mill Pond to look for signs of autumn and the build up to Christmas will provide the children with experiences to hear and say new words to use in their play.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Physical Development</p> <p>The children have had fun using a wide range of equipment to develop their large motor skills outside in the garden, essential for Reading and Writing skills later on. This term we will be using KS1 hall to use the P.E equipment and other resources such as parachutes to extend and challenge the children's development of physical skills.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>Over the Autumn term the children will continue to develop their Maths skills, such as singing number rhymes and counting objects through small adult led activities focussed around Autumn, Halloween, Bonfire Night and Christmas. The children will learn about shapes and measuring through cooking and making Christmas cards.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Nursery Curriculum Overview Autumn Term</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Reading and Writing</p> <p>To develop the children's Reading and Writing skills we will be sharing stories, poems and information books in small groups relating to autumn, Bonfire Night, Christmas and cooking. The children will learn how writing has a purpose when they write their Christmas Lists to Santa and their messages in their Christmas cards.</p> <p>The children will continue to develop their awareness of sounds through phase 1 phonic activities, such as singing, listening and memory games.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Understanding the World</p> <p>To develop our children's understanding and knowledge of their immediate world we will be visiting Mill Pond to see what happens in autumn, discussing traditions such as Halloween, Bonfire Night, Remembrance Day and Christmas. They will also learn songs for our nativity Play and find out how Christmas is celebrated around the world.</p> <p>For ICT the children will be learning how to use our interactive whiteboard programs such as 'splash,' to create firework pictures. Through cooking, the children will learn how technology is used to cook their bread.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">Expressive Art and Design</p> <p>This term the children will learn about different mediums as they explore their new environment inside and outside, through small adult led art activities exploring paints, clay, different types of playdough and junk modelling. Their use of the different mediums will be linked to autumn, Remembrance Day, creating Christmas cards, decorating the role-play as Santa's House and taking part in our Nativity play.</p>
