

<p><b>Geography – Arctic and Antarctic</b> In Geography we will be using our map skills to locate the Arctic and Antarctic regions and identify their features.</p>	<p><b>History – Expeditions and Titanic</b> With Frozen Kingdom as our overarching topic we will be looking at the emigration and exploration in the early 1900s in the polar regions, specifically the Titanic.</p>	<p><b>Science – Living things and their habitat</b> In Science, linked to our topic Frozen Kingdom, we will be looking at the habitat of animals particularly in the polar region.
