Dear Parents and Carers,

Before sharing anything else with you today I would firstly like to express my sincere thanks for all of your food contributions towards the Bracknell Foodbank this morning. It was great to see the community coming together to support each other as we celebrated the theme of 'Harvest' during assemblies this week. The volunteer from the Lions explained that the items would go some way to replenishing their stocks and if you still wish to donate then please send in non-perishable items next week and we will store them within school as the Lions will drop by to pick up any extras but a big thankyou to anyone who have made a donation.

The 'Harvest donations' have brought an end to an incredibly busy week which included the individual photographs yesterday, (thank you for ensuring the children looked as smart as possible), but started with some pupils from Years 3&4 taking part in a netball event. Everyone who took part really made the most of the opportunity and Miss White feels the netball future of the school is in safe hands so well done to all involved.

It was also lovely to see parents of EYFS pupils in school on Wednesday as they learnt a little more about school and in particular, how Reception works and what they can do to best support their child. It is always tricky to find that balance between inviting parents in for opportunities that are worthwhile whilst also understanding that not all parents will be able to make every event, (especially with work commitments), but we appreciate those parents who were able to attend on this occasion.

One event that has however proved incredibly popular is Parents Evening because within a few hours there were only 80 parents/carers who were yet to sign-up. If you are one of these parents and wish to come along, please check your Parentmail account and book an appointment. Parents Evening will provide an opportunity to see the progress your child has made since the start of the year, hear a little bit more about what they are learning but it's also a chance for our teachers to learn a little more from you about your child too! It is also worth reminding everyone that speaking to your child's class teacher in the first instance about any issues/concerns/worries that you may have because they are best placed to deal with any concerns and support your child moving forward.

A real focus over these first few weeks of term has been promoting the importance of good attendance. Hopefully the table to the right gives you a little flavour of how your child's class is getting on but I must report that the overall attendance since the start of the year has been **95.9%** which is higher than the national average and a fantastic achievement!!! There will always be genuine reasons why children can't come in to school but the more they are here, the more they will feel they belong and the more progress they will make so a big well done for your support with this. One thing that will also help punctuality next week is that I have been advised the traffic lights near the main school entrance will be removed once the work is completed over the weekend which will be positive!
