EYFS	<p>Transitions &amp; Stay &amp; Play – welcoming new people into our school community, birthday boards, creating a pack for their new teacher to get to know them (Summer 2) (Starting School, There is a Rhino in our School key texts)</p> <p>Golden Values – why we have them, what they look like in our classroom</p> <p>Looking after each other, modelled in how we deal with behaviour 'If...could say sorry, he would, I'm so sorry that happened to you, How can we make...feel better, Would you like some help with that?' Etc</p> <p>Choosing story books (link to key group times); autonomy and choice, being able to express their opinions</p> <p>Families topic week at the start of the year (The Family Book, My Mum and Dad Make Me Laugh, The Big Book of Families) learning about our similarities and differences</p> <p>Growing up (Peepo Key Text);</p> <p>Our School Community (Aut 1) - learning about people in our school community and who is here to help us</p> <p>Looking at how some celebrations are different around the world eg Christmas, Mother's Day</p> <p>Festivals – main festivals throughout the year Eid, Diwali, Chinese New Year, Christmas, Easter, Hannukah (depending on those celebrated by cohort too) as well as celebrations eg Bonfire Night, Valentine's Day etc. Focus on discussing 'traditions' within our families</p> <p>Reflections of different cultural experiences in the classroom eg role play corner, in diversity texts</p> <p>What is Going on in the World Around Us overarching theme – Children in Need &amp; Anti-Bullying Week, World Maths Day etc.</p>
