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Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been wonderful going in to classes this week to see how our new writing curriculum is having an impact on learning, and it really has increased the level of enthusiasm our pupils have for writing. Whether it is creating a radio advert advocating the rights of a child, writing letters to the local MP to help with homelessness in Bracknell or our youngest pupils designing books to help understand the jobs of different body parts, the end products they are working towards really are providing a renewed focus to their learning and should be celebrated.

Sport plays a key role for pupils in our school and there have been no less than 4 events this week including two football matches (a win and a draw which keeps us in touch with the top of the table going in to the final fixture), a netball match (a valiant loss but they'll have the chance to put it right with a double-header next week) and some Year 2 pupils got to sample a multi-skills event with other schools and Miss Norman was incredibly proud of them all. With children using the field in the summer months if they want to run, chase, cartwheel and handstand then I am all for that, however I have explained to them there is to be no lifting e.g. carrying, lifting, balancing on each other, in order to prevent injuries so if you could remind them of this that would be greatly appreciated. With the arrival of the sunshine it reminds us that summer is on the horizon.

And finally, on the other page you will see an advert from our PTA advertising a Silent Disco for Key Stage 2. Whilst we look forward to your support with this event I understand that our younger pupils might be disappointed they are not invited. However, it is the first time the PTA or I have run a Silent Disco so I want to ensure it can be run successfully before opening the event to Key Stage 1 so thank you for your understanding.
