Sports Day Arrangements

Monday 22nd June – Reception & Key Stage 1 (Years R – 2) & Tuesday 23rd June – Key Stage 2 (Years 3 – 6)

Here are a few reminders about arrangements for both Sports Days:

- Children must come to school wearing their **PE kit** and a **t-shirt** in their house colour (**green, blue, red** or **yellow**)
- It is essential to provide your child with a **hat** and apply **sun cream** before they come to school in the morning
- It is essential to provide your child with a **water bottle** to take on the field
- Please **remove** earrings and jewellery

The front doors will be re-opened after drop-off at 9am with Sports Day starting at 9.30am and finishing at approximately 11.30am. Throughout the morning we will be leaving the **front gate open** to allow easier access to the school premises, (please note the back gate will remain closed). There will be a designated area on the school field for spectators to cheer on their children. We ask that you please remain in this area throughout the events and please remember that teachers are responsible for the children throughout the event, so will deal with any issues that arise. At the end of the event, teachers will take children back to class so please wave goodbye to your child before departing. May the best team win! Due to the hot weather, if there are any changes to the arrangements we will let you know as soon as possible.
