Whilst there might have been a few wobbles about the first day of school for some, the staff within Nursery and Reception have done a fantastic job in ensuring their new environments are great places to be; and the children have thoroughly enjoyed exploring them over the past week. I also know the generosity, (and visibility) of our PTA on these first days of school was also appreciated by parents (and I) as they were each given a small gift because as parents of older pupil's they are well aware that the transition into school can be challenging for everyone, not just the children! But a big welcome to all our new pupils and families who have joined us in Nursery, Reception and across the school; welcome to the Wildridings Community!

With the whole school now fully returned and the term well and truly underway, I thought it would be helpful to provide a few helpful reminders which will hopefully ensure the smooth running of the school on a day-to-day basis:

- Sign-up for Tapestry so you can keep up to date with the learning taking place in your child's class
- BoomReader is now used to record daily reading at home so please make sure you have activated your account
- Punctuality is vitally important therefore the bell rings at 8.45am and children need to be in the classrooms by this time. If you arrive late, please report to the School Office
- No animals, including dogs, are allowed on site at any time
- If driving to school, please ensure you park respectfully so we continue our good relationship with local residents by observing all road markings, e.g. no parking on double yellow lines or in allocated disabled spaces without a blue badge
- Children having watches is actively encouraged to help tell the time, but please, no Smart watches with cameras or messaging capacity
- Pick-up and drop-off times need to be child focussed so ensure mobile phones are not being used at this time
